1. Though overwhelmed by the news of the **novel** coronavirus outbreak, Munyaradzi Gurure, the 21-year-old student at Guangxi University of Finance and Economics from South Africa, has still stepped out to serve as a volunteer in the train station to help battle the epidemic.

2. "I'm well aware the situation of epidemic prevention and control is very severe," he said. "Seeing that many people actively joined in the fight, I also wanted to do my part and volunteer at the station." With the number of novel coronavirus cases continuing to rise both in and outside of China, Gurure's family back in South Africa was very worried about his health, and hoped he would quit the volunteer job. "I told my parents China has taken a lot of strong quarantine measures and is actually safe," he said. "I want to do whatever I can to prevent the spread of the infection. The country took really good care of me during the last three years."

3. Working about four hours a day, Gurure either carries an 8-kilogram electric sprayer to disinfect the waiting room or checks passengers' temperature as soon as **they** walk into the station. He also makes sure people are in good health and wearing masks at all times. 1. Much of the music people listen to today is a mixture of styles from different countries and historical periods. Many modern songs originate from older traditional melodies that were once popular in various parts of the world. Traditional, or folk, music is collected over decades, if not centuries. Younger generations learn these songs from their elders through practice and repetition.

2. Since music can tell us a lot about different cultures through its lyrics, melodies, and the instruments used, researchers and music fans see music as an essential part of history. **They** fear that traditional and older types of music are slowly disappearing, partly because they are less likely to be written down or recorded, or because the format in which they are recorded is no longer in use. Also, younger generations may not find such music very appealing, so once older generations pass away, the music may die out with them. Whole genres of music may go extinct.

3. There is a growing effort to preserve music in its many forms. Some researchers create field recordings – those made outside of a recording studio – to capture live performances. For example, in the early 1900s, social scientist Frances Densmore made recordings of Native American songs that had been sung for many generations but were in danger of being forgotten. Researchers also transcribe old music by listening to old recordings – sometimes the only one of its kind left. They try to write out the music so that it can be studied and played by modern musicians.

4. Collecting music is another form of music preservation. Some collectors are extremely passionate about their music and will spend a lot of time and money looking for things that have not been produced or sold for many years. For instance, some folk musicians from the island of Madagascar and punk rock fans still collect cassette tapes from the 70s, while many jazz fans prefer to listen to old vinyl records. Their efforts help to document the music of different cultures, genres, time periods, and places. There are also associations and societies to preserve and celebrate very specific kinds of music.

5. Now, modern technology makes it much easier to preserve music. Smartphones can be used to record music, while the Internet lets us share these recordings and connect with **like-minded** enthusiasts. Soon, losing a piece of music may be a thing of the past.
